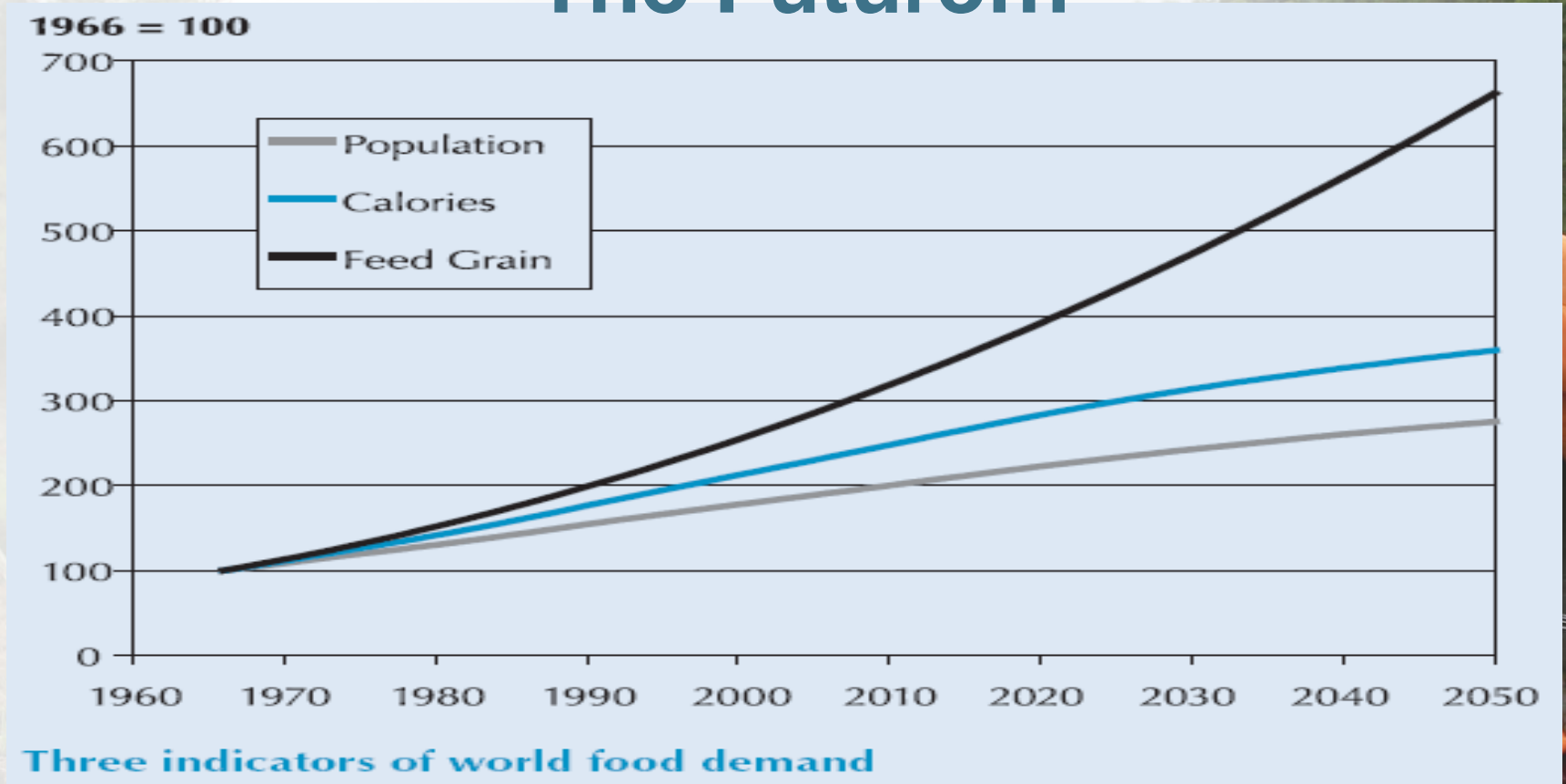
FAO VISION
