CONCEPT FOR PRESENTATION SPACE AND POSTER / BANNER PRESENTATIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

The MSP program in Panama provides one time window on the second day from 1600 to 1830 h for participants to present short papers. In addition the participants will also have the possibility to exhibit posters. The posters can be stand-alone or can support a paper presented in the presentation space. The objective of these presentations and posters is to enhance the networking by informing the MSP participants on specific activities towards sustainable livestock.

2. FORMAT OF PRESENTATION SPACE SESSIONS

The idea is to organize parallel sessions of 4 presentations each 30 minutes during 2:30 hours. The presenters will have 20 minutes to present, followed by 10 minute moderated discussion. Each session will be chaired by a MSP participant, nominated prior to the MSP. The following sessions are proposed:

Session 1: Closing the efficiency gap

Session 2: Restoring value to grassland

Session 3: From waste to worth

Session 4: Knowledge networks

Session 5: Associate agendas and alliances

Session 6: Open space

3. POSTER AND BANNER PRESENTATIONS

Posters normally have an A0 size (841 mm x 1189 mm). Banners have often the same width (841 mm) but can be up to 2000 mm in length). These sizes are indicative. Posters will be posted to the wall with pins or tape, whereas the banners normally come with individual supports provided by the authors. Posters and banners will be exhibited in a prominent place throughout the MSP meeting in the form of a market place. Poster and banner authors also will be provided a limited space to exhibit additional material. Poster and banner authors are invited to organize individual sessions during the MSP meeting. These sessions can take place during breakfast, coffee and lunch breaks.

4. TIMELINE AND PROCESS FOR PRESENTATION SPACE APPLICATIONS

The abstracts should be maximal one page, stating title, presenter, affiliation, objectives, methods, results, discussion and conclusions on the contribution of the presented material towards sustainable livestock production.	
15.06.2016	Deadline for power point presentations and posters/banners, to be included in MSP documentation prior to the meeting	
20.06.2016	Poster/banner presenters take their material along, AST provides exhibition space for the posters/banners and tables for additional material.
