Objective for Regional Consultation

Present **regional impacts of COVID-19** and assess **drivers of change, consequences** and stakeholder **responses to the challenges** caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in the four sustainability domains of **food and nutrition security, livelihoods and economic growth, animal health and animal welfare** and **climate and resource use**.

Identify options in the short, medium and long run, on **how the livestock sector could improve its response** through a sustainable livestock approach with **solutions of multi-stakeholder nature**.



Outcome from Regional Consultation

The regional outcomes will be **tailored to each region's particular conditions** and will have a **common base for global consolidation** of results by orienting the discussion towards COVID-19's **impacts and mitigation actions** under **different livestock production systems and the four sustainability domains**, in addition to **actions to prevent a future sanitary crisis**.

The **North America Regional consultation** will be documented in proceedings from this call and will be **presented to the Global GASL MSP meeting on September 15th**.
