**REGIONAL CONSULTATION (Oceania):  
Embracing change and harnessing diversity: The roles of livestock in sustainable food systems**

### MEETING OBJECTIVE

This year's Global Agenda for Sustainable Livestock (GASL) has as its theme, **Embracing change and harnessing diversity: The roles of livestock in sustainable food systems**

The 2021 GASL Global Multi-stakeholder platform (MSP) meeting takes place at an important time. The UN Food Systems Summit process will set out global to local agendas to 2030, including for the livestock sector. In November, the COP 26 meeting will focus policy makers on climate adaptation and mitigation targets, actions and priorities, with significant implications for livestock production.

Given the virtual nature of the GASL MSP meeting to be held on **7 to 11 June 2021**, regional consultations will be held to provide input into the preparation of this MSP, as well as providing inputs to the UN FSS process.

#### MEETING CONTENT

The meeting will cover background to the UN Food systems Summit (FSS) and GASL sustainability domains. It will enable discussion to identify up to 3 challenges in Oceania associated with livestock that are critical to achieve each of the FSS action tracks. For each of the critical challenges, participants will identify one or two 'game-changing' actions or outcomes/solutions for Oceania that could be achieved by 2030. This information will be collated by the organisers and presented at the June GASL MSP.

This regional (**Oceania**) consultation will emphasize the roles of livestock in sustainable and resilient food systems with the focus of embracing change and harnessing diversity. A key input will be illustrating practice change and initiatives and innovation leading to practice change.
