GUIDANCE TO CONTRIBUTE POSTERS, VIDEOS AND TECHNICAL SESSIONS

The multi-stakeholder partnership meeting provides space for participants to present posters and show video or other multimedia products with the goal to enhance networking and share specific activities, best practices, and tools to support livestock sector actions towards more sustainable food systems. These can be in-person in Dublin or virtually only.

Poster presentations

Posters normally have an A0 size (841 mm x 1189 mm) and will be posted with pins or tape. Posters will be exhibited in a prominent place throughout the MSP meeting in the form of a marketplace that all participants can attend. Poster authors also will have a limited space to exhibit additional print or other materials. Poster authors are encouraged to also organize individual sessions during the MSP meeting, during breakfast, coffee, and lunch breaks. All posters will be included in the virtual poster space.

Video screenings

There will be limited possibilities to screen video or other multimedia products. A short video could also be screened as part of a parallel technical session or in the poster exhibition.

Parallel technical sessions

The event provides opportunities for short technical sessions for participants to discuss specific issues in more depth. In total, the meeting can accommodate 18 sessions of 30 minutes each (three sessions in parallel).

These sessions aim to enhance networking and share specific activities, best practices, and tools to support livestock sector actions towards more sustainable food systems. The parallel sessions will be face to face with limited facilities for online participation. The organizers are free to use the 30 minutes at their discretion. However, they should use interactive formats (panels, discussions, etc.). Since time in the session is limited, we



encourage session organizers to also submit posters that can be viewed throughout the event.

Parallel sessions should if possible contribute to the themes covered in the matrix contained in the event concept note.

Contributors are invited to submit details using the online form provided. The GASL MSP task force will screen the application and select 18 contributions. Contributions not selected for parallel session will have the option to present a poster.

15 September 2022	Deadline to include final information in event documentation prior to the meeting
30 September 2022	Deadline to deliver virtual posters for the online segment of the MSP meeting. Participants should bring material for in-person display to the meeting. GASL provides exhibition space for the posters and tables for additional material. GASL will upload posters into the internet and provides equipment to screen videos. For the parallel sessions, organizers will have meeting space and presentation equipment. No interpretation is available.
