Community gets free biogas and bioslurry

18 Thai pig farmers with a biogas digester, donate their surplus biogas free of charge to a plastic piped grid reaching 1,500 households in the Praekha community. The farmers use the biogas to generate electricity for their farm operations. One farmer reported saving up to 50 percent of his electricity expense. He also gains extra income by selling sun-dried bioslurry as organic fertilizer. Bioslurry from other digesters is distributed through pipelines, again free of charge, to fertilize nearby palm oil orchards. [\[read more...\]](#)
